Administrative Items:

Fire Police Resolutions

Ms. Twardowski requested adoption of Resolutions 16-30 and 16-31 authorizing fire police to assist Limerick Township with the 4th of July Fireworks at Waltz’s golf farm and at PV West for the meet the teacher night in September. The resolution also authorizes Schwenksville and Perkiomen Fire Police to assist at PV West if needed.

Zieglerville Road culvert failure

Ms. Twardowski informed the board that a sinkhole had developed on Zieglerville Road between Schwenk and the curve at Main Street due to the collapse of a steel pipe. The Township has ordered 2 steel plates as this is the second time in two years that we have needed to borrow plates. Ms. Schuehler has worked on a simplistic design to replace the pipes with concrete pipes. She asked for authorization to get pricing for the replacement.

A motion ratifying the purchase of 2 steel plates at a cost of \$2100

A motion approving Ms. Schuehler to acquire pricing for the replacement of cross pipe

Colonial Park

Ms. Schuehler discussed with the board that during the installation of sewers in Spring Mount a lot of fill dirt would need to be disposed of. She suggested taking the dirt to Colonial Park and creating playing fields with it as this was the original intent for the park. She suggested that at this time as it would be a good way to utilize material that we would otherwise have to pay to dispose of. We would need to apply for an NPDES permit. The Supervisors agreed that this was a good idea.

- Mr. Yoder questioned whether the business at 20 Main St has been expanding.
- Mr. Kerwood asked if what if there were any permits or plans submitted for 1467 N. Gravel
