Cuddy Park Enclosed Dog Play Areas

Part of the Montgomery County Open Space Program, Cuddy Park is a 12+ acre park named in appreciation for Lorraine Cuddy's 30 years of service as the Lower Frederick Township Manager. Your dog will love to play in the securely enclosed dog park. Bring your family and make new friends. Enjoy a picnic in the pavilion equipped with wheelchair accessible picnic tables and a nearby charcoal grill. Observe wildflowers and native plants on the gentle gravel walking path and along an enclosed meadow.

Park Amenities:

Two fenced dog play areas, each equipped with dog waste stations and trash cans;

Additional dog waste stations equipped with waste bags and trash cans on the walking path and in the outer fenced area of the park;

Paved parking with 20 spots and one handicap spot;

Porta potty, trash cans and electric;

20' x 40' pavilion equipped with 4 picnic tables, 2 of which are wheelchair accessible;

Charcoal grill;

Wildflower and native plant observation on the 4/10 mile gravel walking path around the park and along a mowed path through an enclosed meadow, and
Bench near the dog play areas.
