





A year of construction

Is drawing to a close.









51 homes within 150 LF of main can be required to connect.



15 more homes can connect, may be 150 feet or more from main.



7 properties with existing force main connection will be reconnected.



14 existing vacant lots along route that can connect.



Two more homes on Bavington have requested connection by grinder pump.



Complete pump station to accept flows

Re-connect properties with existing grinder pump connections.

Complete restoration of all easements, staging areas, and pump station.


Pump Station

The Pump station should be ready to accept flows near the end of this month.

(PECO just connected in the electric power today!)



Residents will be notified when the system is ready to accept new connections.



Homes within 150 feet of the new sewer main are required to connect.





Plumbing connection from home to sewer lateral stub/cleanout must be installed by a Licensed Plumber.






Homes will connect by gravity feed or grinder pump

If your plumber advises you will need a grinder pump to connect, a grinder pump design is necessary.

The Township sewer engineer can assist with grinder pump design for a fee.






Approximately 82 sewer lateral stubs were installed to provide a point of connection for each existing property along the sewer route.


The laterals stubs terminate with a cleanout to grade at the road right-of-way.






Gravity Sewer Connection

Hire a plumber

Topics to discuss with your plumber:

- -Service to the basement level
- -Price should include pumping out existing septic tank(s)
- Price should include proper abandonment of existing septic tank(s)
- Price should include restoration of lawn and/or driveway area
- Complete Lower Frederick Township Plumbing Permit Application
- Bring Completed Plumbing Permit Application to the Township Building
 - At time of application submission, pay for the sewer tap in fee (\$7,405.26), sewer connection fee (\$250), and plumbing permit application fee (\$75)

*Please bring two checks in the amount of:

Check 1: \$7,655.26 (tap in/sewer connection fee) Check 2: \$75.00 (plumbing permit application fee)

Checks should be made out to Lower Frederick Township





- LTL Consultants processes plumbing permit within 15 business days
- LTL Consultants approves permit application and gives permit to Lower Frederick Township
- Lower Frederick Township contacts the permit applicant to advise of permit approval and permit cost. The permit will need to be signed by the applicant.
 - *Please bring a check in the amount owed for the plumbing permit
 - *Checks should be made out to Lower Frederick Township*
- Approved work can begin
- Plumbing permit will list required inspections. Contact LTL Consultants directly to schedule any & all inspections listed on the plumbing permit.
- Once final inspection is complete, LTL will issue and send the applicant a Use & Occupancy Certificate. This serves as proof of completed project.

For safety, existing septic tanks or cesspools must be properly abandoned.



Connecting by Grinder Pump



For properties where the sewer piping exiting the building is lower than the new sewer main, a grinder pump will be required.

Grinder pump systems must be installed by a licensed plumber and under a Connection Permit obtained through the Township.

Grinder Pumps must be designed by an Engineer. The Township Sewer Engineer can help. If you want assistance from the Township Sewer Engineer, inform the Township.

Individual property owners will be responsible for operation, maintenance, and repairs to the grinder pump system, and will be required to enter into a grinder pump agreement with the Township.

GRINDER PUMP CHECKLIST:

Hire a Plumber:

Topics to discuss with your plumber:

- -Your quote should be for a semi-positive displacement pump, such as the E/One
- -Service to the basement level
- -Price should include pumping out existing septic tank(s)
- -Price should include proper abandonment of existing septic tank(s)
- -Price should include restoration of lawn and/or driveway area

Engineered Design of Your Grinder Pump:

Option A: Hydraterra Professionals (Township Waste Management Engineers)


- -Tell the township when dropping off paperwork and they will notify Hydraterra to contact you directly to arrange an onsite visit, to begin the design.
- -A Hold Harmless will need to be signed at time of paperwork drop off
- -A cost of \$500 dollars will be owed for the grinder pump design/plan

Option B: Hire your own engineer, but Hydraterra will need to review and approve the plans

- -Tell the township when dropping off paperwork
- -Bring (2) sets of the grinder pump design/plans to be submitted and reviewed by Hydraterra (this needs to be done before the plumbing permit will be issued)
- -A cost of \$500 dollars will be owed for the grinder pump plan review
- Complete Lower Frederick Township Plumbing Permit Application
- Sign Grinder Pump Agreement

Bring Completed Plumbing Permit Application and Grinder Pump Agreement to the Township Building
At time of application submission, pay for the Sewer Tap In Fee (\$7,405.26), Sewer Connection Fee (\$250), Grinder Pump Plan/Review Fee (\$500), and Plumbing Permit Application Fee (\$75) *Please bring two checks in the amount of: Check 1: \$8,155.26 (tap in/sewer connection/grinder pump design or review) Check 2: \$75.00 (plumbing permit application fee) *Checks should be made out to Lower Frederick Township*
Once the township has received the approved grinder pump design plans, they will forward them to LTL Consultants, along with the Plumbing Permit Application.
Permits will be processed within 15 business days. LTL Consultants approves permit application and gives permit to Lower Frederick Township
Lower Frederick Township contacts the permit applicant to advise of permit approval and permit cost. The permit will need to be signed by the applicant.
*Please bring a check in the amount owed for the plumbing permit *Checks should be made out to Lower Frederick Township*
Approved work can begin
Plumbing permit will list required inspections. Contact LTL Consultants directly to schedule any & all inspections listed on the plumbing permit.
Once final inspection is complete, LTL will issue and send the applicant a Use & Occupancy Certificate. This serves as proof of completed project.

Re-Connecting by Grinder Pump



The contractor (DOLI) has been directed to re-connect homes along **Riverside Avenue** already connected to the Township system by grinder pump and force main. Those homes will be connected to the new sewer line. No need to hire a plumber, unless you are changing to a gravity connection.





Up to \$25,000 Financial Assistance is available to Homeowners to pay for connection to public sewer.

LOAN TERMS:

- Fixed interest rate for life of loan, as low as 1.75 percent. Up to 20 years to repay the loan balance.
- The loan must include the construction costs and can also include the tapping fee.
- The property must be owner occupied to qualify for the loan.
- The Township will request a PennVest representative be available to meet with residents


